

SALES AT CONFERENCES

OUR April issue seems to have made its mark in several ways. We have had notes from many regular readers welcoming the introduction of Pat Sloan's monthly 'Survey'. Geoffrey Drain's article was rapidly quoted on the opening page of the April 2 issue of another journal, *Municipal Engineering*, under a picture of NALGO and NUPE members in Edinburgh on a joint march against cuts in public expenditure.

A reader in Cheshire showed her appreciation of the article by Solly Sachs, adding £1 for the fund (which will of course be acknowledged in our next issue; the March contributions are listed below).
